



Important – Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

• Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.

• Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

• Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.

• Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

• During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.

• Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.

• Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

• Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



• To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

Care and maintenance

• Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

Handy Hints

• Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts • Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightend properly.


To help prevent product toppling over please follow the below steps:-

Use the anti tip strap or wall fixing method provided (if applicable) Do not allow children to climb or hang on the furniture Do not open more than one drawer at a time Do not place heavy items in the top drawers Do not place heavy items on top of the furniture, unless the furniture has been designed for this purpose

Please note that only the anti tip strap is provided. You will need to provide wall plugs and screws applicable for your wall type

The screws length is measured from the head to the point (30mm screw shown).

Step 1

Connect the male camlock as directed in the assembly instructions using a screwdriver.


Step 3

Insert the female camlock as shown in the instructions.

Note: ensure that the arrow on the top of the camlock points towards the entry hole for the male camlock.

Step 2

Push the male camlock into the entry hole.



Step 4

Turn the female camlock clockwise with a screwdriver.

You should feel a click when the camlock is locked in place.

The joint is now secure.




Adjusting Hinges


Hinge adjustment:


a:To move the door in or out, loosen screws shown and move top panel to suit.


Retighten screws


b:To move the door left or right, adjust screws shown.















Attach top part (7) to part (1, 2, 3), then insert and secure cam lock (B) to part (1, 2, 3) to lock it. 8











When the hinges are installed properly and adjusted as needed, doors on both sides should cover side panels completely, and doors in the middle should not bump into each other while opening. If the end product is not as shown, you could ① first check out if the right hinge is screwed on the right place; ② secondly re-adjust the hinges referring to the guide on page 4; ③ or thirdly, if things are still going wrong, please feel free to reach out to our support team for help.

Step 14

The unit is floor standing, but it is recommended that the unit is secured to the wall.

1. Move the unit into desired position.

2. Mark the wall with a suitable scribe the position of the fixing holes.


Warning: Before driling,check wall for hidden pipes and cables.


3. Drill holes and insert 2 x wall plug

4. Attach 2 x Wall Straps to to the top of the unit using 2 x Washers and 2 x Screws

5. Secure the straps to the wall using 2 x Washers and 2 x Screws

Note: To hide the straps behind the unit, drill the holes lower than the top of the unit
