DRAWER ADJUSTMENT STEPS


NOTE:

Gently lift the drawer, align the screw with the gourd-shaped hole, and then snap it in.

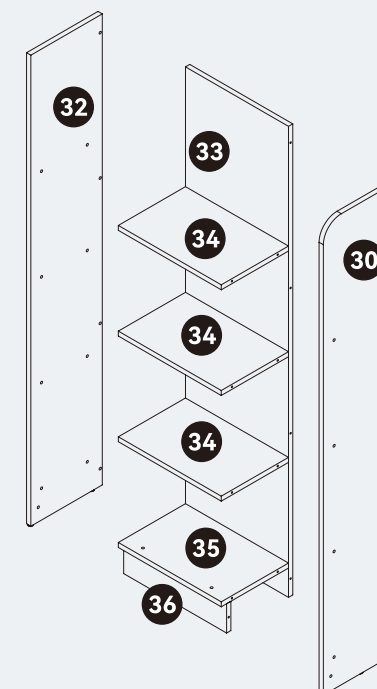
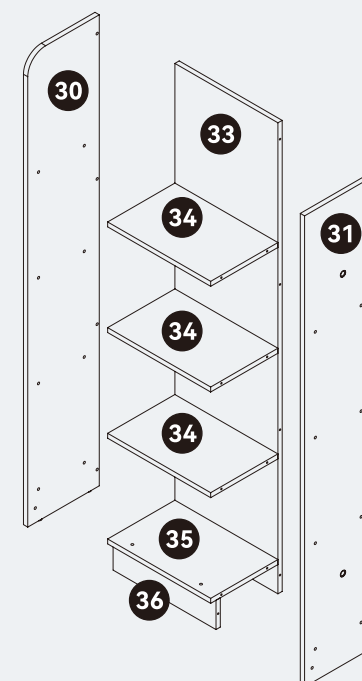
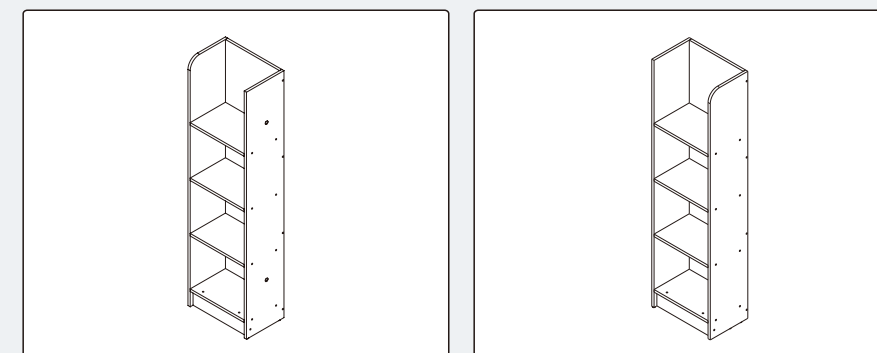


As shown, slide drawer (T5) into the slots on parts (1) and (2).

Installing the Bed Drawer:

Carefully lift the drawer from the bottom with your hand to provide proper support. Align the hooks on the drawer with the notches on the bed frame. Once aligned, gently push the hooks into the notches on the bed side until they are securely locked in place. Ensure the drawer is stable and properly connected before releasing it.
