In each of the previous steps, tighten all screws to approximately 70% to stabilise the overall frame during assembly. Do not fully tighten any screws until the final step is completed.

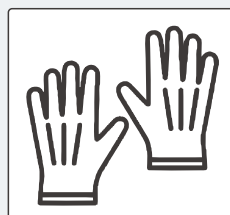

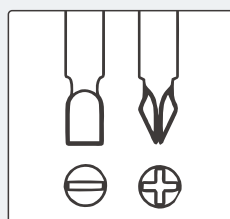

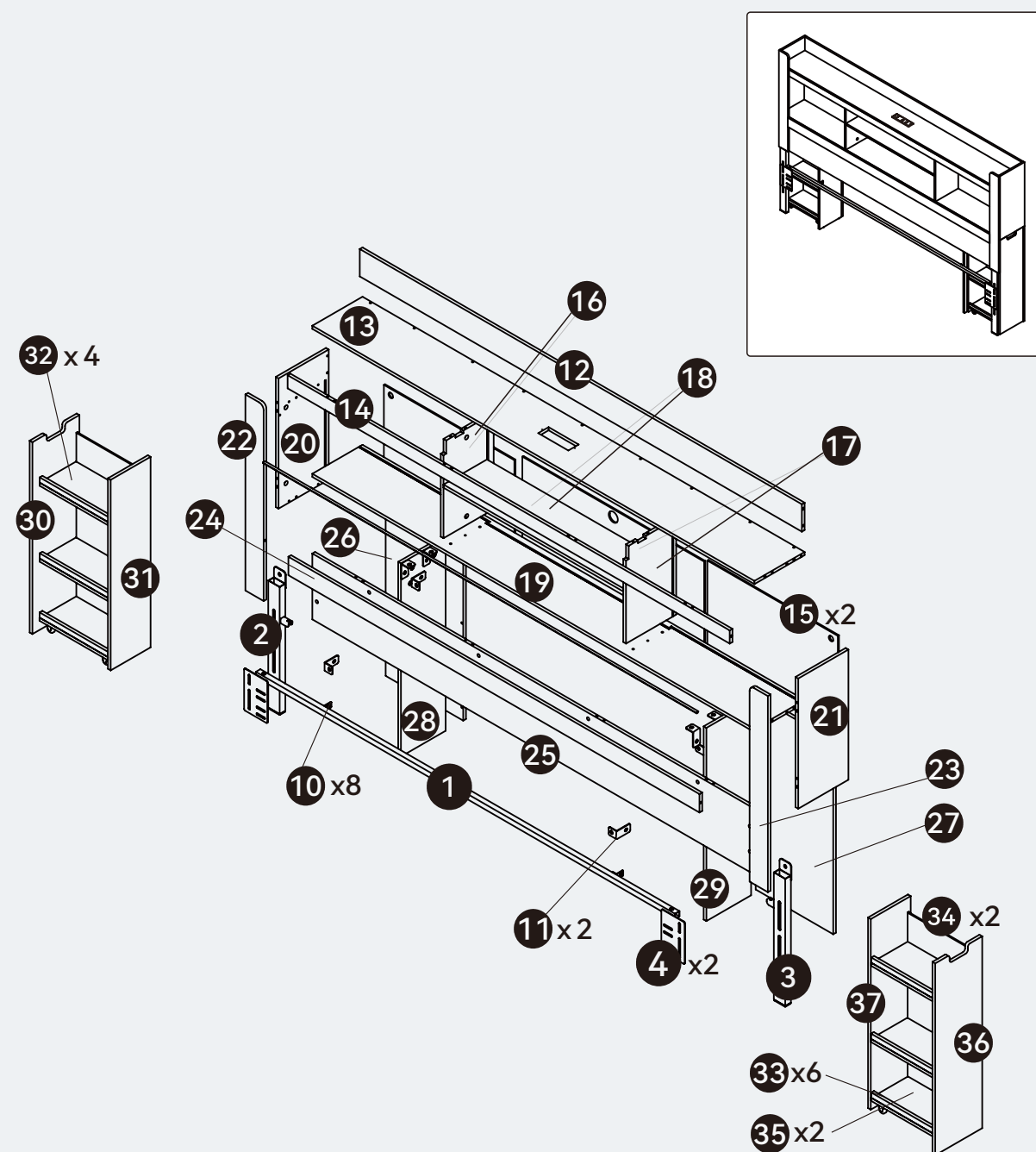

Headboard Section Installation

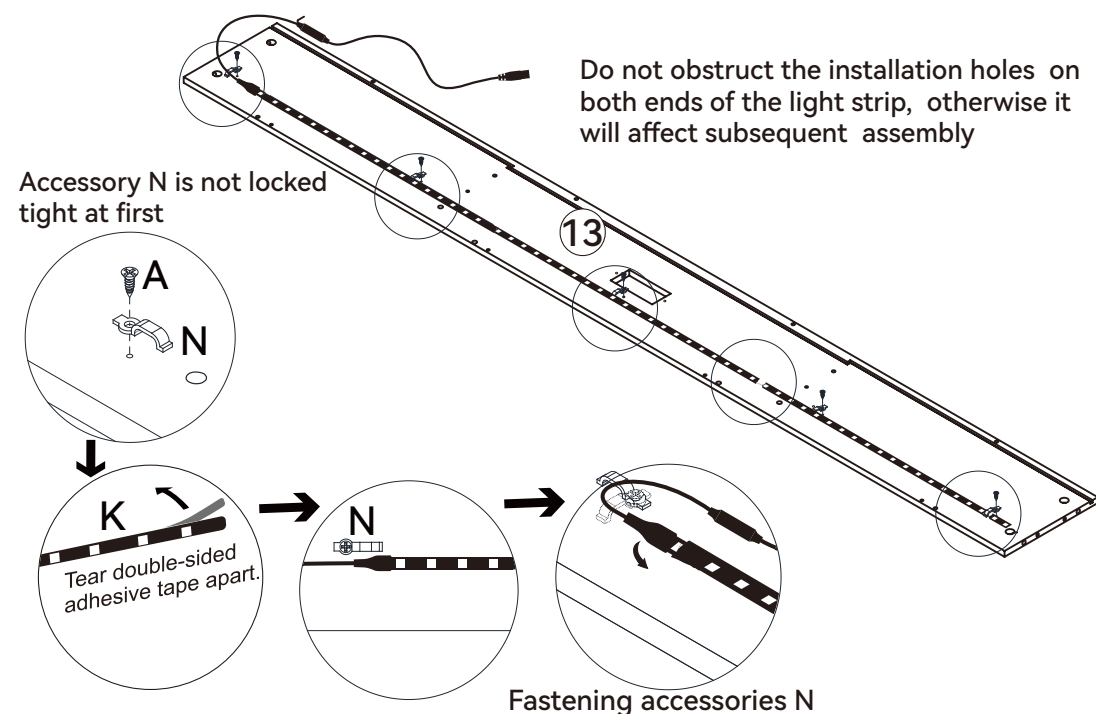

Note:

Ensure all hardware components are accounted for before beginning assembly. Missing or damaged hardware should be reported to customer service for replacement.

The headboard section assembly requires a total of labeled panels shown in the diagram. Please locate all of them and prepare them for use.

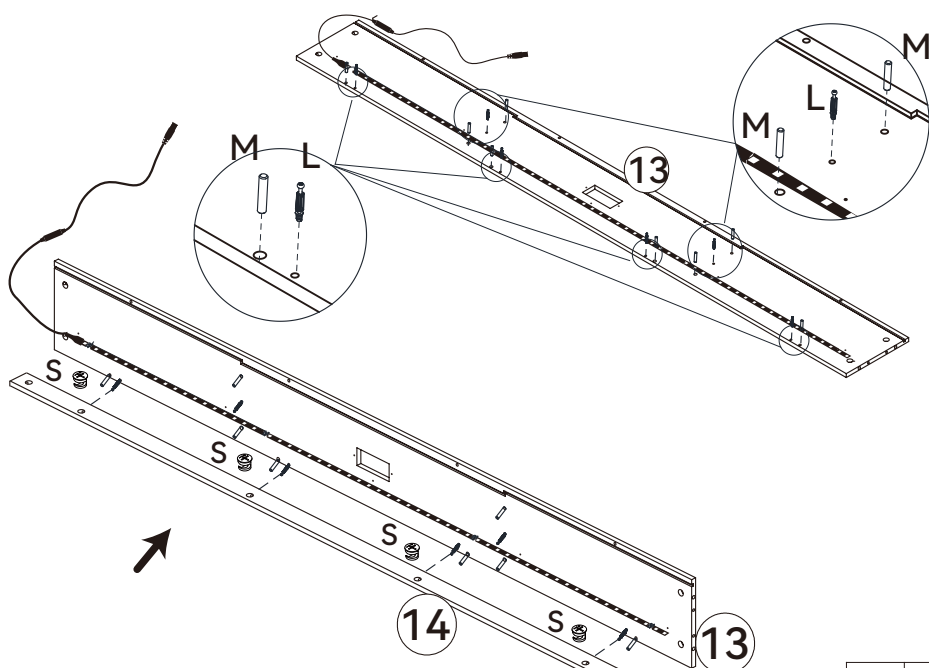


As shown in the diagram, adhere the LED strip (K) to panel (13). Install the retaining clip (N) onto panel (13) using screw (A) to secure the LED strip in place.

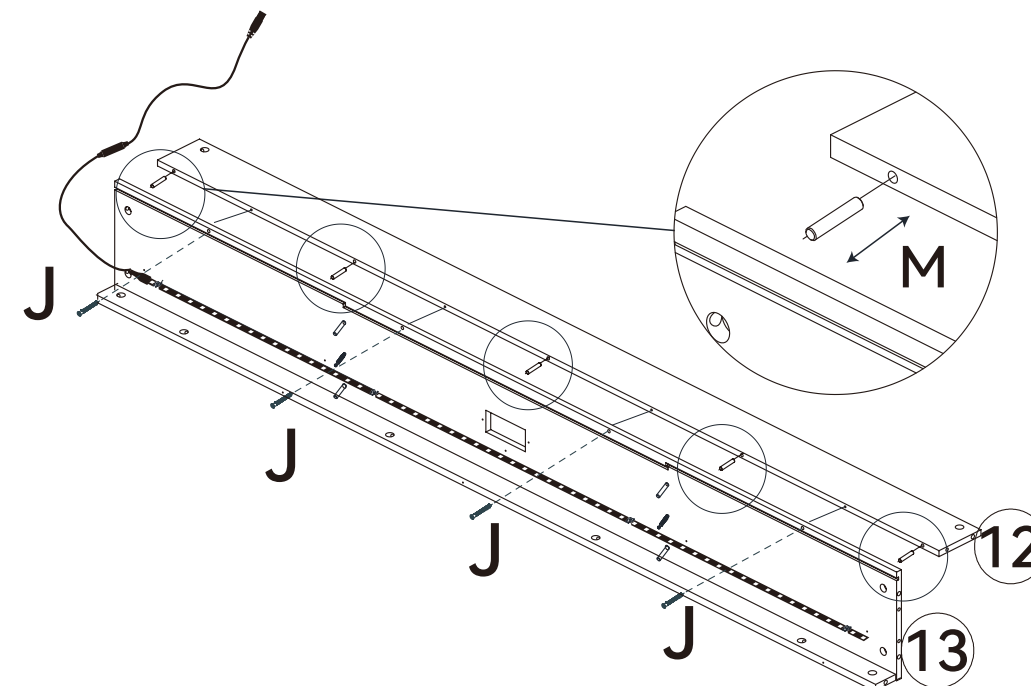


Screw bolt (L) into panel (13). Insert wooden dowel (M) into panel (13). Join panel (13) to panel (14), then lock them securely using the 2-in-1 furniture connector (S).

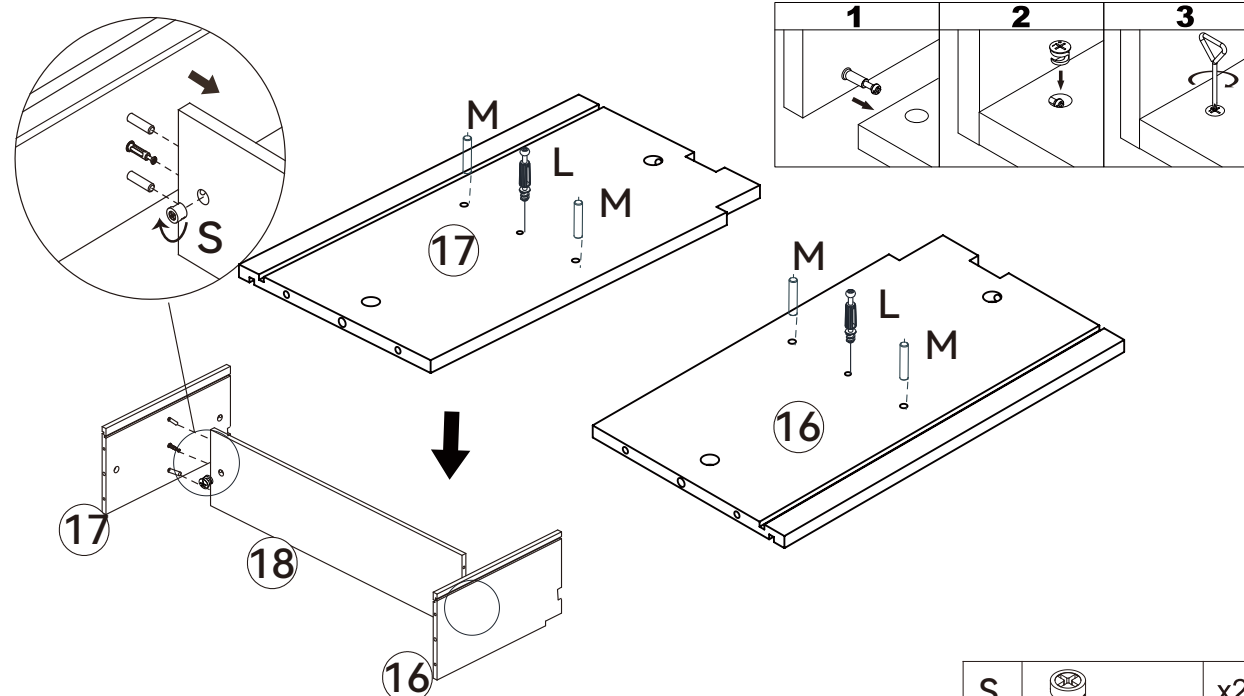


Insert wooden dowel (M) into panel (12). Join panel (12) to panel (13), then tighten and secure further with screw (J).

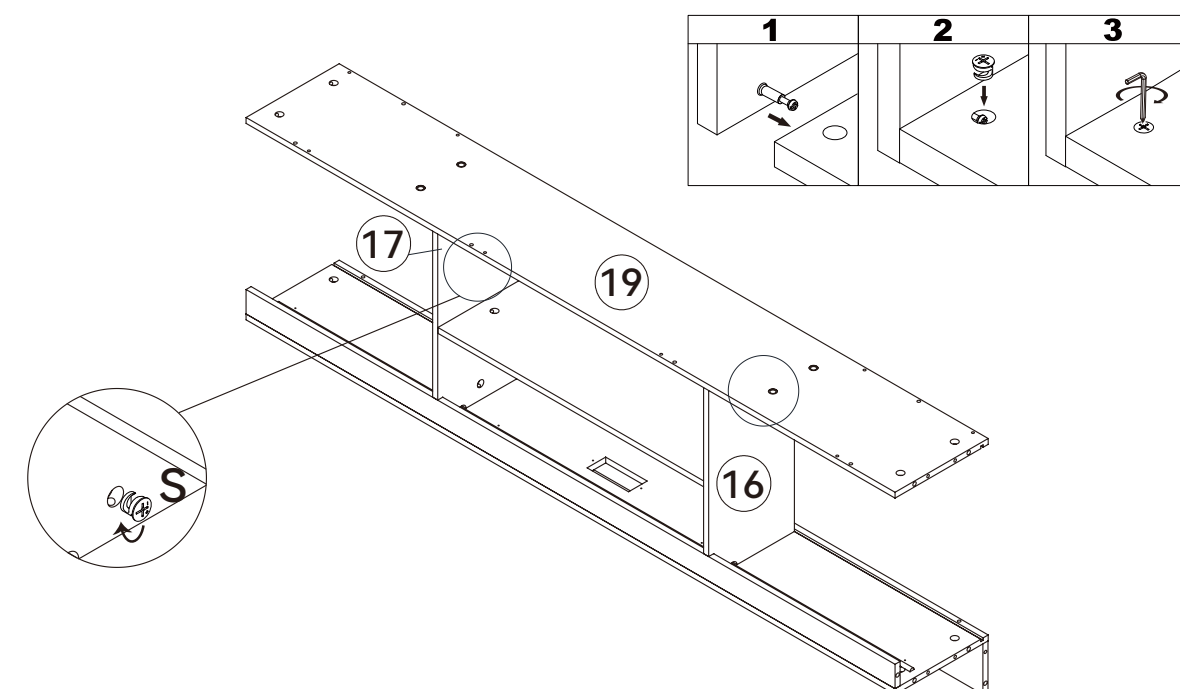


Insert panel (43) into the slots of panels (16) and (17), then complete the connection using panel (19).

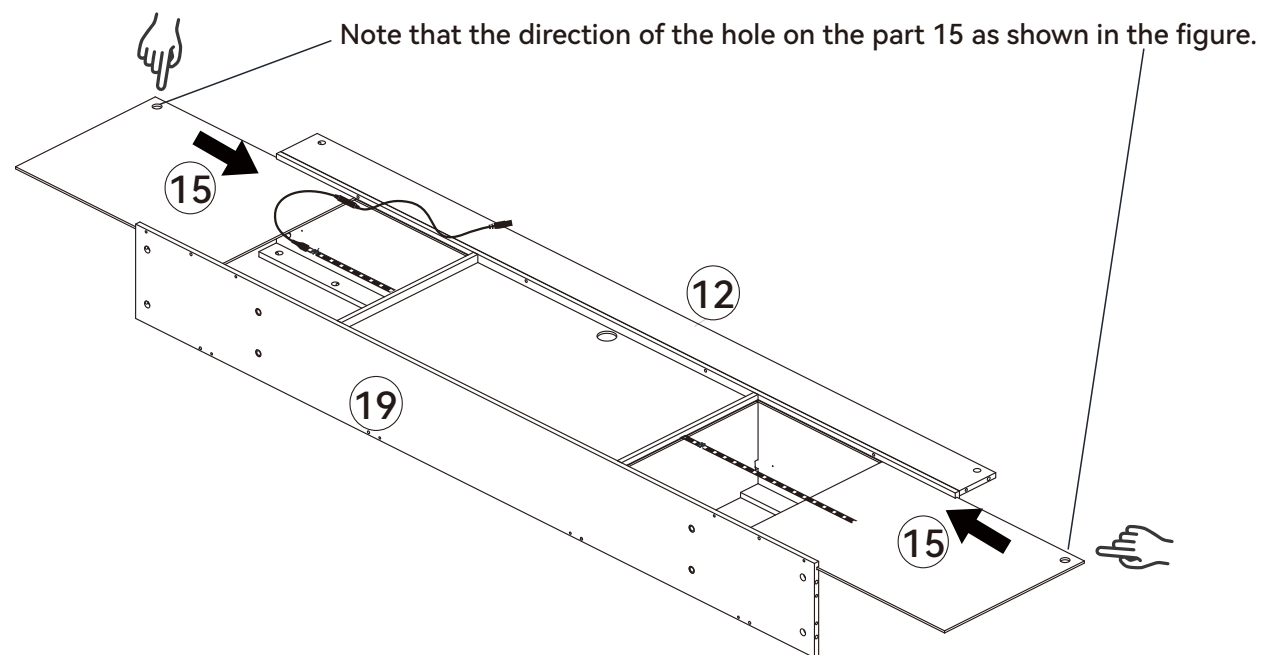


As shown in the diagram, securely lock the bolts connecting panel (19) to panels (16) and (17) with the 2-in-1 furniture connector (S).

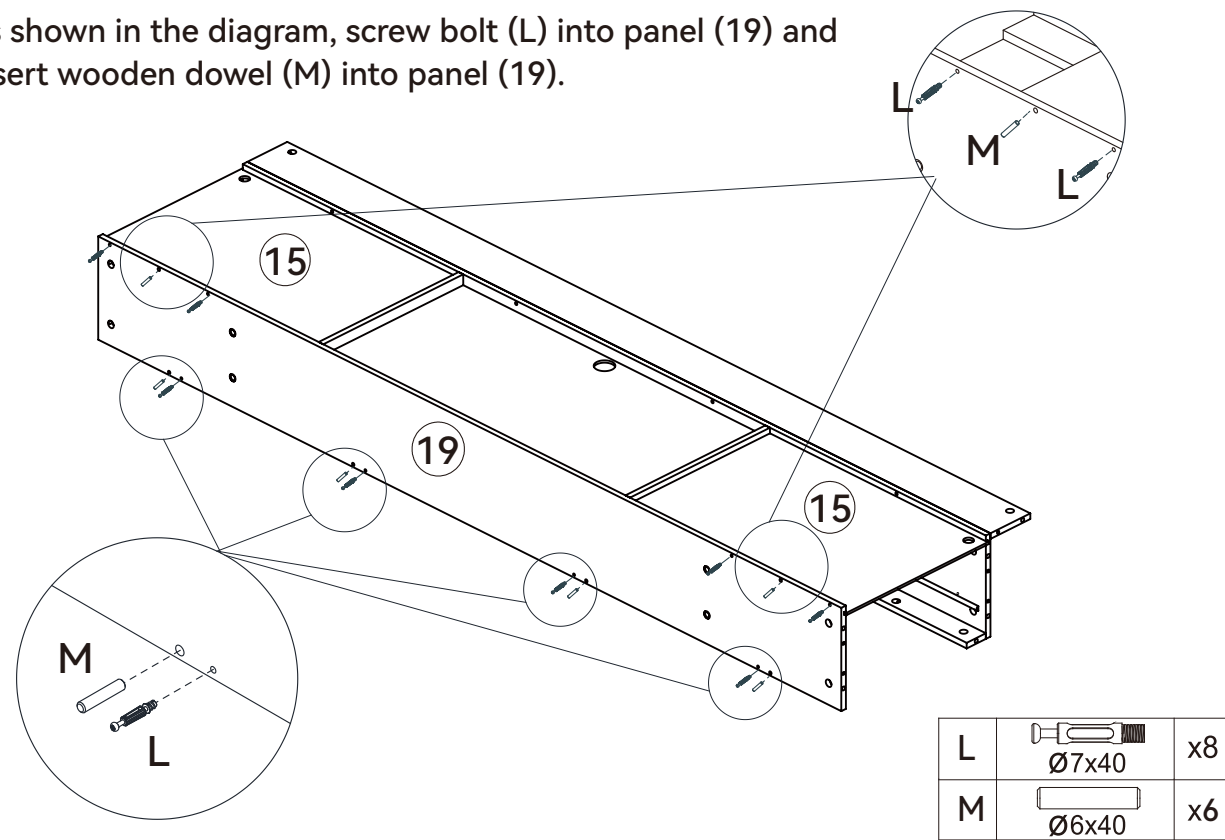


As shown in the diagram, slide panel (15) into the slots of panels (19) and (12) until fully seated.

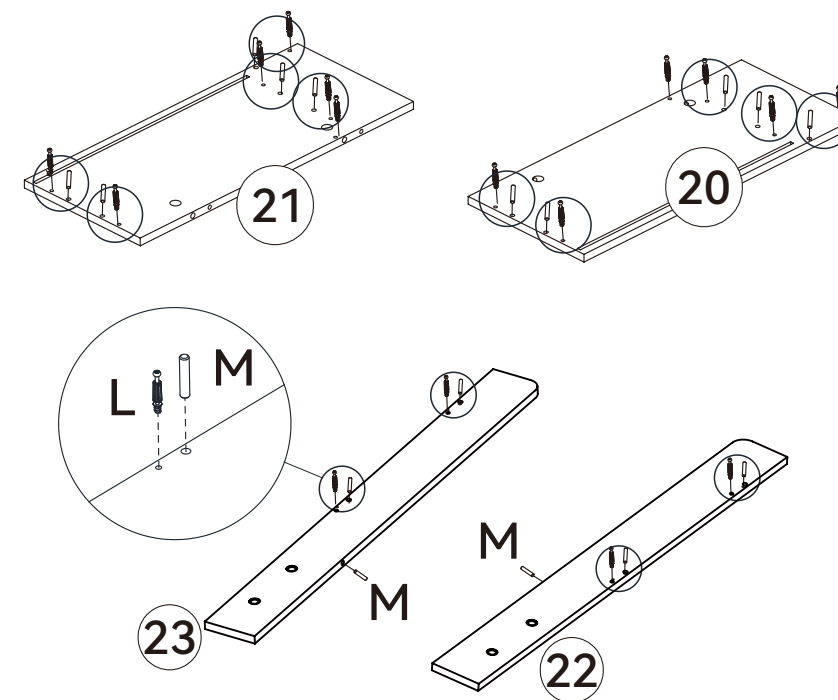

As shown in the diagram, screw bolt (L) into panel (19) and insert wooden dowel (M) into panel (19).

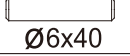

As shown in the diagram, connect panels (28) and (29) to panels (19) and (25) using L-bracket (10), then secure with screw (C).

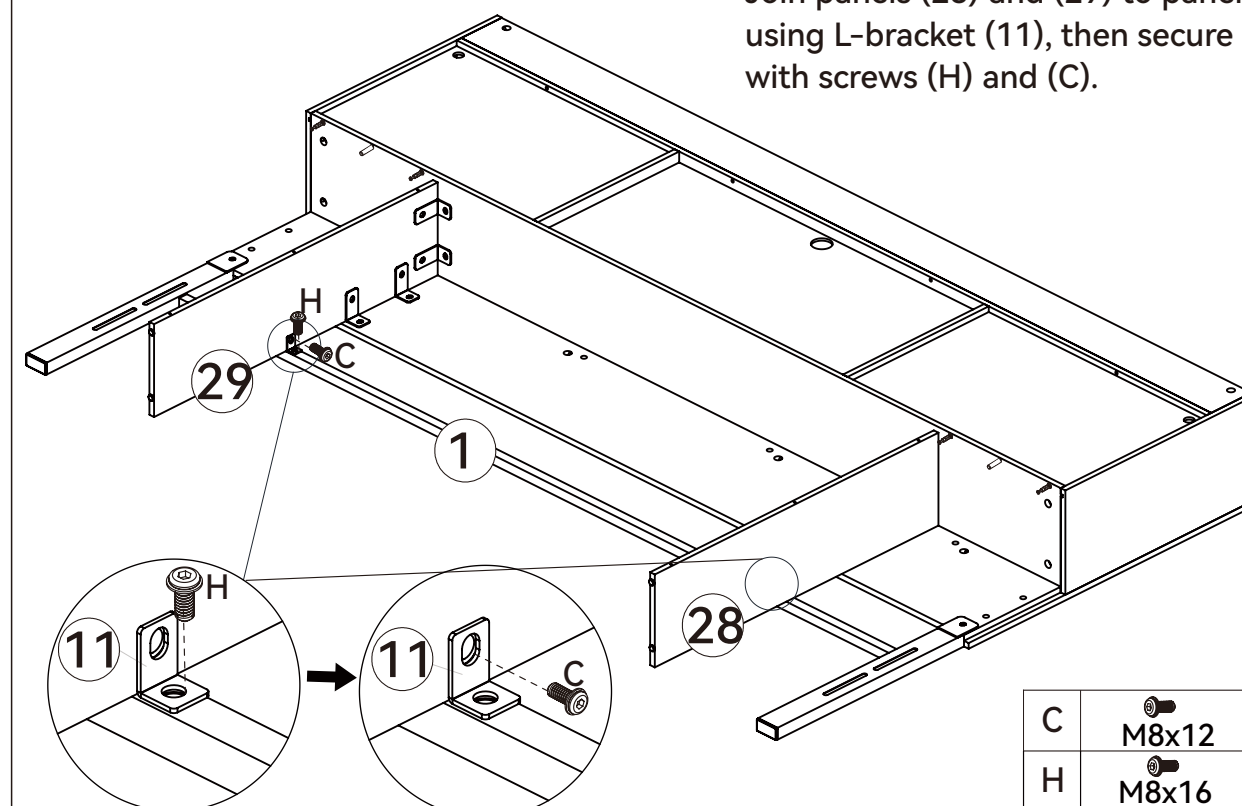

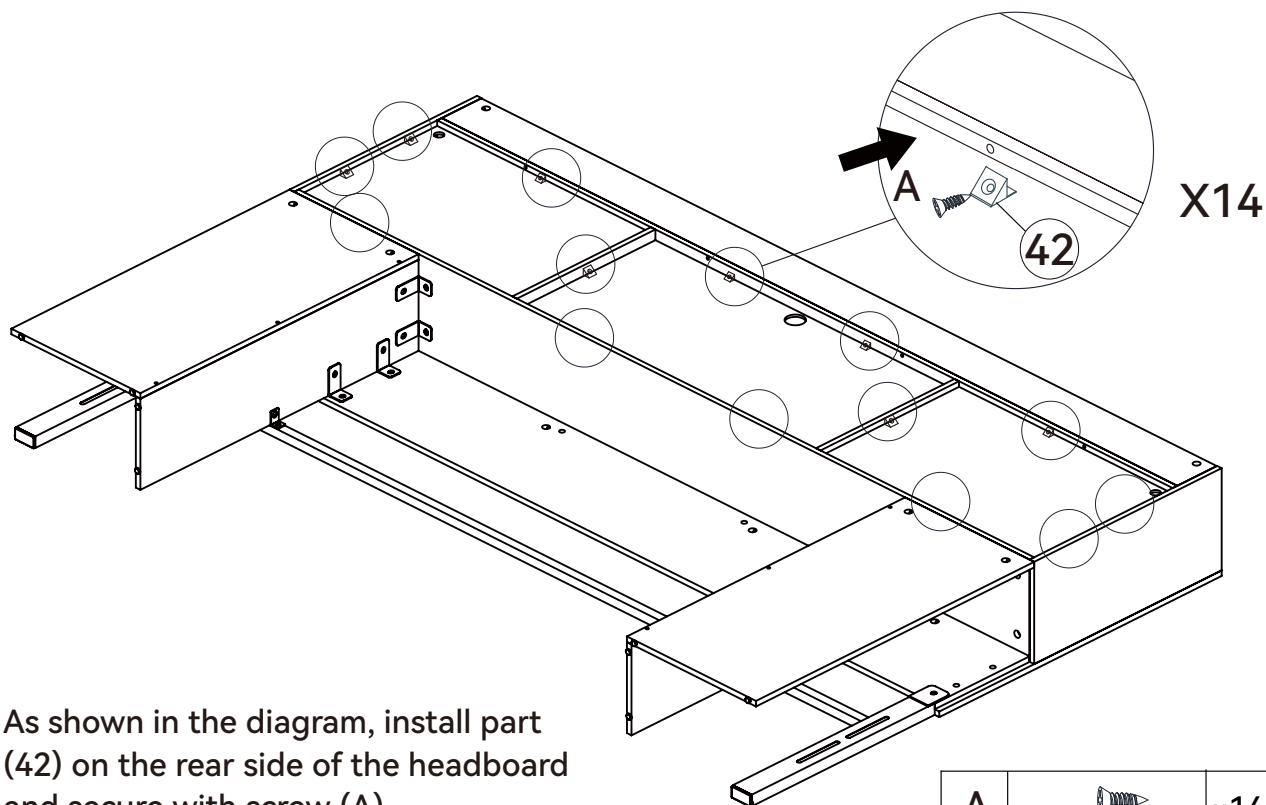

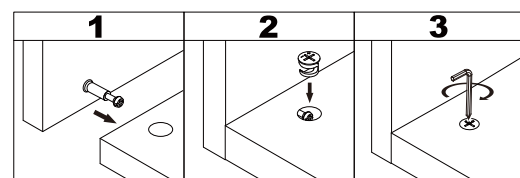


Screw bolt (L) into panels (30), (31), (36) and (37) respectively.

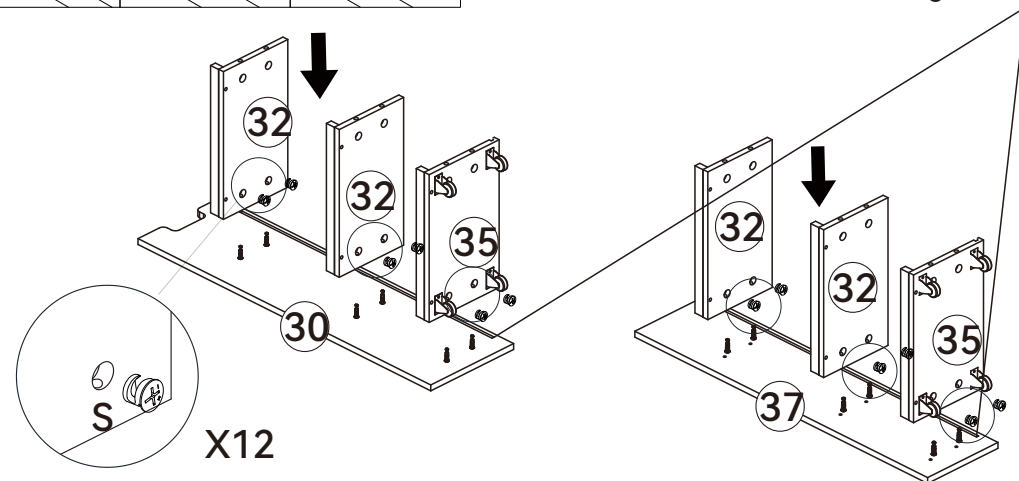

Please ensure that the grooves are facing each other.



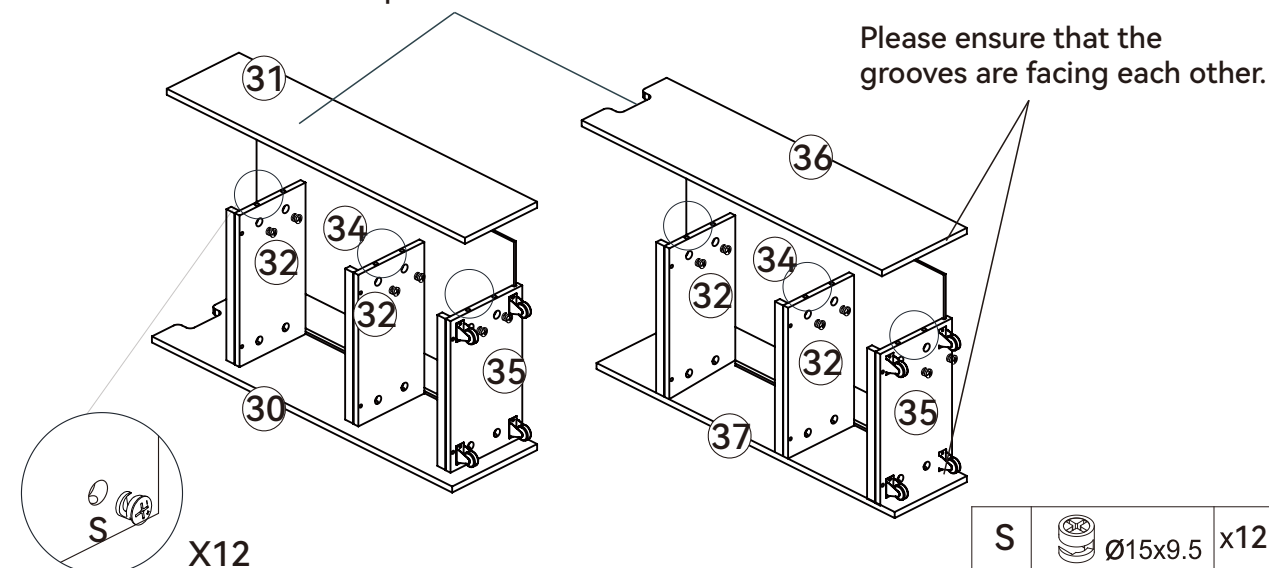
Join the two pieces of panel (32) and one piece of panel (35) to panel (30), then lock and secure tightly with the 2-in-1 furniture connector (S).
